"It was a bit blustery throughout the weekend, which caused some problems for stallholders, but the crowds still came. This festival really puts Geraldine on the map. It was another successful weekend. I'm sure our local community saw the benefits," festival committee chairperson Sonia Higgins says.

Sonia, who is retiring after seven years steering the festival committee, praises the efforts of her hardworking committee.

"An event of this magnitude doesn't just happen by itself. We're so lucky to have this small group of dedicated people who work so hard behind the scenes. They are simply amazing," she says.

The theme "Garden Grotto" inspired some amazing creations and continued through from business windows and display pots to the floral art display and contributions from local schoolchildren at the art exhibition.

"The response from schools was fantastic once again. We have some fabulous talent coming through so we know the festival will be in good hands for the future."
